Volunteers Needed at H1N1 Mass Vaccination Clinics

The Southeast Idaho Medical Reserve Corps has asked its volunteers to participate in H1N1 Mass Vaccination clinics, but additional help is needed from community volunteers. The Southeastern District Health Department and County Emergency Management have established plans to provide mass vaccination clinics for priority groups in the coming weeks and months, as vaccine becomes available. Healthcare workers with experience providing vaccinations are needed. Non-medical volunteers are needed to assist with directing crowds, processing paperwork, and other duties.
